SERVING

ACTS has served the children of Springfield for more than 25 years, offering FREE one-to-one tutoring and mentoring.

We currently serve about 80 Springfield elementary school students at nine sites around the city. Each child is matched with a volunteer tutor who mentors and tutors the student under the guidance of a Site Director. The Site Director and tutor develop lessons and activities to meet each child’s learning needs.
